He has worked with major international development agencies including World Bank, the IFC, DFID and USAID. He has published 15 books on international economics, regional integration, small and medium enterprises, development economics and development finance. His books include: *Economic Reforms, Regionalism and Exports: Comparing China and India*, East West Center, 2011; *Asia's Free Trade Agreements: How is Business Responding?* Edward Elgar, 2011; *A World Trade Organization for the 21st Century: Asian Perspectives*, Edward Elgar, 2014; *Production Networks and Enterprises in East Asia*, Springer, forthcoming; and *Infrastructure to Bridge South Asia and Southeast Asia*, Edward Elgar, forthcoming. He is an associate editor of the *Journal of Asian Economics*. He holds a DPhil in economics from Oxford University and a BSc in economics from the London School of Economics.
